**ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TRAINING FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONAL :  
"HEAVY METALS EXPOSURE AND HEALTH EFFECTS"**

Environmental Health Unit, Disease Control Division, Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) in collaboration with Environmental & Occupational Health Unit, Selangor State Health Department, myJICA and Malaysian Society of Environmental Epidemiology (MySEE) organised training for health professionals on health effects of heavy metal exposure from 20<sup>th</sup> till 21<sup>st</sup> February 2019. The training was held at Auditorium Agensi Anti Dadah Kebangsaan, Bangi Selangor and attended by 89 participants from all over Malaysia. The participants are Public Health Specialist, Medical Officer, Pharmacist, Researcher, Lab Analyst and Environmental Health Officer from all over Malaysia. Among attendees are Ms Akaishi Fumiko, JICA Representative and Mr Norazizul, President of myJICA.

The session started with opening speech by Representative of JICA Office Malaysia , Ms Akaishi Fumiko.

The main objective of the training is to create awareness on the health effects of heavy metals exposure among health professionals. This one and half day sharing session is based on the experience gained through the JICA training course attended by the speakers in Japan. It focuses on three important heavy such mercury, cadmium and arsenic. The topics given were :

- Mercury pollution in Minamata Bay: Past and present of Minamata disease

Taman Kinabalu dipilih disebabkan ia mempunyai tapak warisan bentuk muka bumi di negara ini khususnya Sabah. Kinabalu kawasan ini dipelihara kepada generasi kini dan juga masa depan bukan sahaja untuk fungsi ekologi tetapi untuk tujuan pendidikan, rekreasi dan pembangunan ekonomi," katanya.

Beliau berkata, tapak Kinabalu Unesco

Global Geopark akan melonjakkan imej Sabah di peringkat dunia seterusnya meningkatkan perkembangan industri pelancongan.

Katanya, ia sekaligus akan membawa manfaat sosio-ekonomi kepada komuniti tempatan yang terlibat dalam inisiatif itu.

"Secara tidak langsung ia akan mewujudkan banyak peluang pekerjaan khususnya berkaitan dalam industri pelancongan serta perniagaan," katanya.

8 Oktober ini. Mengulas lanjut, Stephen berkata pembekalan bangunan radiologi itu adalah antara inisiatif yang dilaksanakan dalam memajukan kualiti perkhidmatan di hospital di negeri ini.

"Antara kemudahan yang sangat mesedak adalah kekurangan tempat letak kereta terutamanya di lima buah hospital besar di negeri ini termasuk Hospital Queen Elizabeth 1 dan 2, Hospital Likas, HDOK dan Hospital Besud.

"Kita akan memohon peruntukan dan berharap permohonan ini akan diberikan kos jualan ringgit. Kita akan usahakan demi kesejahteraan rakyat," katanya.


