The 36th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of myJICA was held on 05 May 2024 in a hybrid format, both virtually and physically at the Adamson Hotel in Kuala Lumpur. The meeting was officiated by Mr. Norazizul bin Abdul Aziz, President of myJICA, and was attended by 33 members from across Malaysia, including representatives from the Sarawak Chapter.

















The Japanese Cultural Day, held on 7 November 2024 was celebrated as a remarkable showcase of Japan's vibrant heritage and traditions. The event was graciously organised at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, Universiti Malaya by the renowned student organisation – the Global Network Club (GNC) together with the patron of the Japan International Cooperation Agency Alumni Society of Malaysia (myllCA).

The event was reported to serve as a dynamic platform for cultural exchange, drawing enthusiastic participation from all campus community either from students, faculty, and international attendees. It was designed to bring Japan's essence to life, featuring an immersive lineup of interactive activities that seamlessly blended education, entertainment, and authentic cultural engagement.

Attendees were said to have been captivated by the diverse range of experiences, from the intricate art of Japanese flower arrangement (ikebana) and Japanese art of folding paper (origami) to the elegance of the Japanese tea ceremony, all guided by Japanese students studying in Universiti Malaya. These students, acting as cultural ambassadors, reportedly shared personal insights and traditions, creating meaningful connections and fostering a deeper understanding of Japan's values of harmony, mindfulness, and creativity. The organizers emphasized that this approach allowed participants to move beyond passive observation, enabling them to engage directly with Japanese customs in an authentic and enriching way.
